How to Set Up Your Own Payment Account (for Clients)

Here's a quick guide to help you create a secure and professional payment account so you can send or receive payments easily.

Option 1: PayPal

Best for: Simple personal or small business payments.

Steps:

- 1. Go to www.paypal.com
- 2. Click **Sign Up** (top right)
- 3. Choose Personal Account or Business Account
 - Personal is fine for basic sending/receiving
 - Business is better if you receive regular payments
- 4. Enter your name, email, and create a password
- 5. Add your bank account or debit card to send/receive money
- 6. Verify your email and bank info

To receive payments:

Send people your PayPal email or create a PayPal.me link for easy sharing

Option 2: Stripe

Best for: Professionals, service providers, websites, or those selling online.

Steps:

- 1. Go to www.stripe.com
- 2. Click Start now or Sign up
- 3. Enter your email, name, and password
- 4. Follow the steps to:
 - Add your business info
 - Connect your bank account
 - Verify your identity
- 5. Stripe will walk you through how to create **payment links** or accept card payments online

Option 3: Square

Best for: In-person businesses, wellness practitioners, coaches.

Steps:

- 1. Visit www.squareup.com
- 2. Click Get Started
- 3. Sign up with your name, email, and password
- 4. Fill out your **business info**
- 5. Link your bank account
- 6. Use the dashboard to create **invoices**, **checkout links**, or sell items/services

Tips:

- Use a business email address if possible
- Keep login info secure
- Connect a bank account you check regularly
- If selling products/services, make sure to describe them clearly in the payment request

Option 4: Venmo

Best for: Simple mobile payments between individuals or small, informal businesses.

Steps:

- 1. Download the Venmo app
 - Available for free on the App Store or Google Play
- 2. Create an account
 - Open the app and tap Sign Up
 - Enter your name, phone number, and email
 - Create a secure password
- 3. Verify your phone number and email
 - Venmo will send you a code to enter in the app
- 4. Link a payment method

- o Go to Settings → Payment Methods
- Add a bank account, debit card, or credit card
- 5. Set up your Venmo username
 - o This is what others will use to pay you (e.g., @YourName)

To Receive Payments:

- Simply give clients your **Venmo username** (e.g., @JaneSmith)
- OR use your **Venmo QR code** (found in the app under the "Scan" tab)
- You'll get notified when someone sends you money
- You can then transfer money to your bank account manually or set up autotransfers

Important Notes:

- Venmo is primarily for personal use but you can upgrade to a Venmo Business Profile if you're accepting payments professionally.
- Business profiles allow you to:
 - Accept credit/debit cards
 - o Track business income
 - Appear more professional
- \bullet To create a business profile, go to $\textbf{Menu} \to \textbf{Business Profile}$ in the app and follow the setup
